# ADSL - Asymmetrical Digital Subscriber Line

Technology for high-speed transmission in the local loop – at speeds of 16 kbit/s to 640 kbit/s (upstream) and up to 8 Mbit/s (downstream) – via a standard copper twin wire over a distance of approximately three kilometers.

# ATM - Asynchronous Transfer Mode

Internationally standardized technology for broadband data transmission that provides flexible transmission rates of up to 622 Mbit/s. Deutsche Telekom's ATM services are offered under the brand name "T-Net-ATM".

# Backbone

The main part within a supra-regional or global network architecture that connects local subnetworks; backbones are normally very high-speed links (in the Mbit/s and Gbit/s range).

# Call-by-call selection of a telephone company

Dialing procedure that enables a telephone customer to use the carrier (long-distance operator) of his or her choice for long-distance and international calls (i.e., the customer can change carriers for each call).

#### Call center

A company, or department of a company, that offers operator-supported voice services. A large number of operators handle inbound calls via a hotline, with outbound calls being part of direct marketing efforts.

## Carriers' carrier

A network operator who provides network services to other telecommunications companies.

## DAB - Digital Audio Broadcasting

Transmission of radio broadcasting signals in digital form according to the EUREKA standard.

# Extranet

Intranet data transfer via the Internet. Geographically remote branches of a company can be interconnected via the extranet if a direct intranet connection is too costly. Data security can be guaranteed, for example, by using cryptic methods.

# Firewall software:

A company's central access to an information and communication service in an external location (e.g. in the Internet) is called a gateway or firewall and is a logical system (software) which protects the private network against unauthorized access from external locations.

## FrameLink Plus

Deutsche Telekom's Frame Relay service.

#### Frame Rela

One type of Fast Packet Switching technology: transparent, connection-oriented layer 2 packet protocol with variable packet length. Frame Relay permits considerably higher throughput and lower delays than Datex-P. Used for applications that require fast transmission rates (2 Mbit/s or faster), especially for LAN coupling (WAN backbone) and host-computer applications.

# freecall 0800

The Germany-wide toll-free service number which companies provide to enable their customers to call them toll-free.

#### **Global Intranet**

Intranet IP solution where the data packets are transported worldwide on a standard platform. Since customers are not connected with the public Internet at any time, this solution meets highest security standards.

## **GPRS - General Packet Radio Service**

A technology allowing higher data transmission rates in GSM networks.

# GSM - Global System for Mobile Communications

A pan-European mobile communications standard for the 900-MHz frequency range.

## Interconnection

Term used for linking networks of different providers, as regulated by the Telecommunications Act.

## Internet/intranet

The Internet is a worldwide IP-based computer network that has no central network management. Intranets, on the other hand, are managed IP networks that can be accessed only by specific user groups.

# IntraSelect

Deutsche Telekom's IP-based VPN (Virtual Private Network) solution for intranets/extranets with guaranteed transmission quality. All kinds of information (such as multimedia, voice and video) can be transmitted over IP-VPNs. Customers can choose from four classes of quality and transmission rates between 64 kbit/s and 155 Mbit/s.

# IP - Internet Protocol

Nonproprietary transport protocol in layer 3 of the OSI reference model for inter-network communications.

# ISDN - Integrated Services Digital Network

Integrates telecommunications services such as telephony, fax or data communications within one network. Digitization improves transmission quality and increases the transmission rate compared to traditional, analog transmission systems. Furthermore, ISDN also provides packet-switched data transmission.

# LAN - Local Area Network

Local network that covers a short-distance region; LANs usually have decentralized network management.

# LeasedLink

Deutsche Telekom's service in the area of fixed connections (leased lines, point-to-point circuits); fixed physical transmission path between two data terminal devices that remains operational all the time.

#### Multimedia

Term used for real-time integration of text with still images and graphics, video and sound.

#### Optical fiber cable

Data-transmission medium consisting of ultra-pure quartz glass. Optical fiber cables have higher transmission capacity (in the Gbit/s range) and lower signal distortion than copper cables.

#### PCS - Personal Communication Service

Service that integrates the fixed network with mobile communications services for residential customers and small business customers.

# Peering

Data exchange between individual sub-networks in the Internet.

## Portal site

Central point of entry to the Internet with an intelligent and personalized user interface that helps online customers navigate the content offered.

# Preselection

Preselection of a telephone company. Procedure in which the customer selects a certain provider – known as the long-distance carrier – for all of his or her long-distance and international calls.

# Remote service

Remote configuration, maintenance and repair of technical systems. Usually implemented using data links. The system must be designed accordingly by the manufacturer.

#### Roaming

A feature of cellular mobile communications networks: Activated mobile stations remain accessible, regardless of location, in all radio cells of the entire area served by the network. Roaming can also include similar networks of different network operators, as is the case with international roaming in the pan-European GSM system.

# Self service

Alternative service and support option which enables the customer to find and repair faults himself or herself. There are various troubleshooting tools available on the Internet for download, e.g., software updates and instructions for use. The most interesting tool is the FAQ (frequently asked questions) section where the customer gets the right answers to his or her queries and can also add new questions to the list that will be answered by our experts.

#### Switched services

Services based on the switching function of the network that permit temporary communication between network users.

#### Switched transit

A carriers' carrier transit service for calls that originate outside Germany and are routed through Deutsche Telekom's network for termination in a third country.

#### T-D'

Deutsche Telekom's GSM standard mobile communications service.

#### T-DS

Deutsche Telekom's ADSL service.

#### T-InterConnect

High-performance network platform (155 Mbit/s) for Deutsche Telekom's Internet communication applications.

#### T-InterConnect World Wide Transit

A solution for the worldwide interconnection of independent IP networks, based on the border gateway protocol. When using this solution, major companies and Internet service providers benefit from the high transmission capacity of T-InterConnect.

## T-ISDN

Deutsche Telekom's ISDN network.

# T-ISDN dsl

Service combining Deutsche Telekom's T-ISDN line and T-DSL.

#### T-LAN

LAN (Local Area Network) service of Deutsche Telekom.

#### T-Net

Deutsche Telekom's digitized telephone network.

#### T-NetBox

Answering machine integrated in Deutsche Telekom's T-Net.

#### T-VPN

Deutsche Telekom's VPN product line for customized virtual network solutions.

## **Telematics**

Technology integrating telecommunications and information technology.

# **UMTS - Universal Mobile Telecommunications System**

International mobile communications standard of the third generation that integrates mobile multimedia and telematics services in the 2-GHz range.

# Unified Messaging

Combination of the fixed-network box, the mobile-phone box and the e-mail box to form a joint TelekomBox. The customer may retrieve and process all messages sent to any mailbox (voice, fax and e-mail) from any access (fixed network, mobile telephony or online).

#### Videostreaming

Streaming allows users to watch or listen to video and audio files while they are being transmitted (in the Internet, for example), provided the bit rate does not exceed the (Internet) access line's rate.

# VoIP - Voice over Internet Protocol

Technology for establishing telephone calls via the Internet. There are three methods: PC to PC, PC to Phone, Phone to Phone

# **VPN - Virtual Private Network**

Customized network that is mapped virtually in Deutsche Telekom's networks (T-Net, T-ISDN).

# WAP - Wireless Application Protocol

WAP enables content to be made visible on the mobile phone display.

# WDM - Wavelength Division Multiplex

The WDM principle allows the transmission capacity of existing optical fiber networks to be multiplied, by using various wavelengths simultaneously.

# Wireless LAN

A local wireless network for highly flexible data communication in the in-house area or on campus. Can serve as an extension or alternative to a wired LAN. Wireless LAN data links offer users the greatest degree of flexibility for call setup and a high level of mobility.
