Dividend announcement

On 27 May 1999 the Shareholders' Meeting of our company approved the payment of a dividend of DM 1.20 individual no par value share on the dividend-bearing capital stock of DM 13,716,200,500 as at 31 December 1998, payable as of 28 May 1999.

The dividends will be paid by Deutsche Börse Clearing AG, Frankfurt on Main, via the depository banks, less 25% capital gains tax and a 5.5% solidarity surcharge on the capital gains tax (a total of 26.375%).

Combined with the dividend is a tax credit amounting to 3/7 of the dividend. This credit, like the capital gains tax and the solidarity surcharge, is set off against the income tax or corporate income tax paid by domestic shareholders who are not exempt from these taxes.

The deduction of capital gains tax and the solidarity surcharge on the capital gains tax does not apply to shareholders who have submitted to their depositary banks a non-assessment note from the tax authorities. In such cases the tax credit will also be granted by the bank making the payment. The same applies in toto or in part to shareholders who have submitted to their depositary bank an exemption order as long as the amount of the exemption specified in the order has not been used up by other capital gains.
